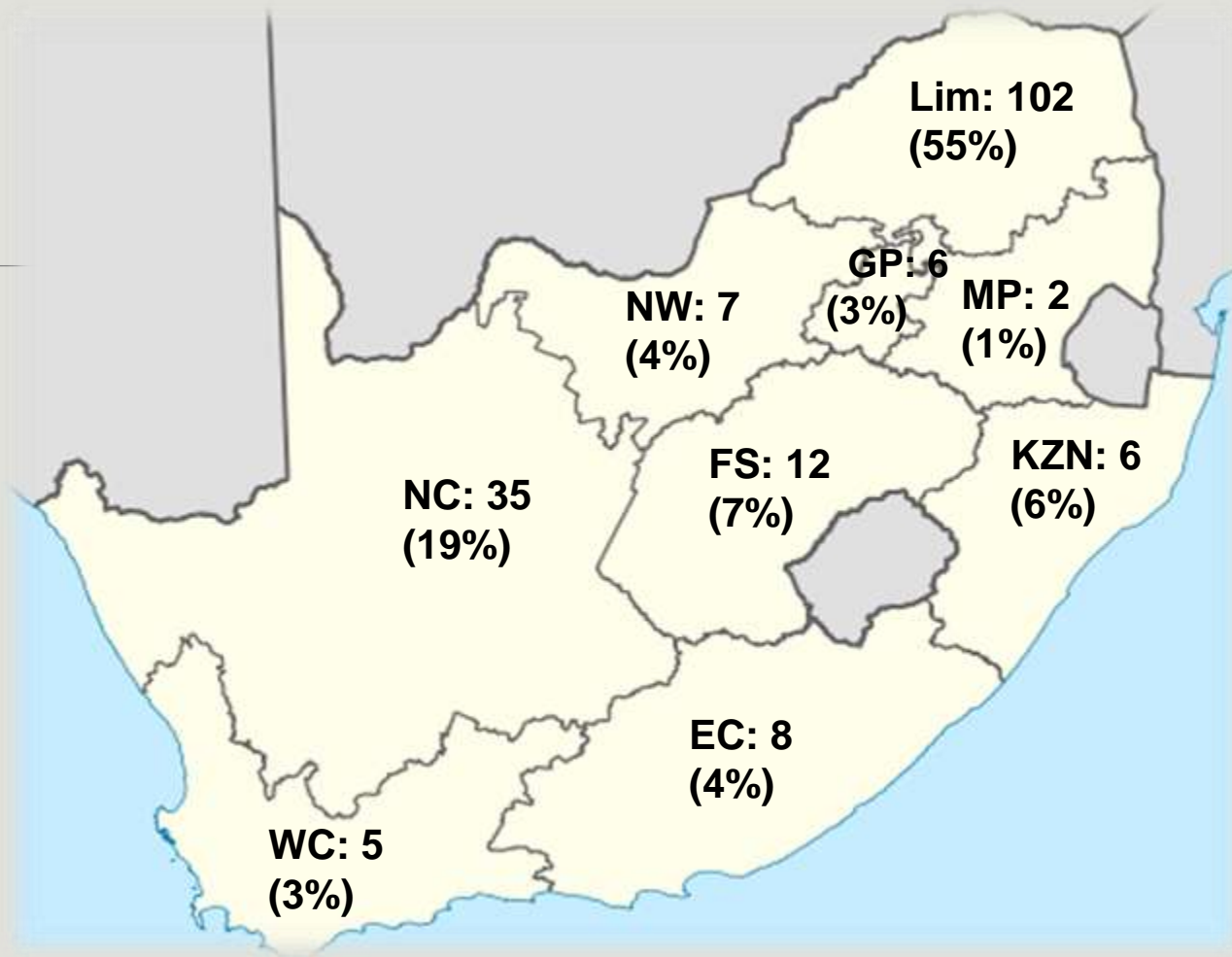

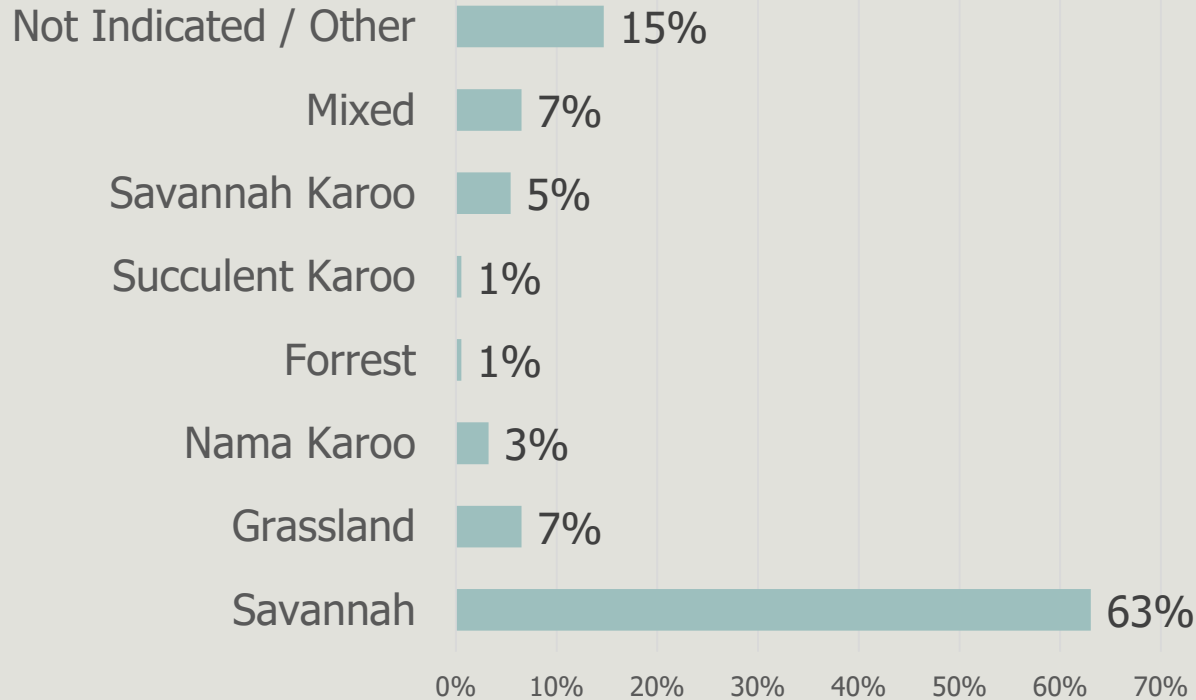

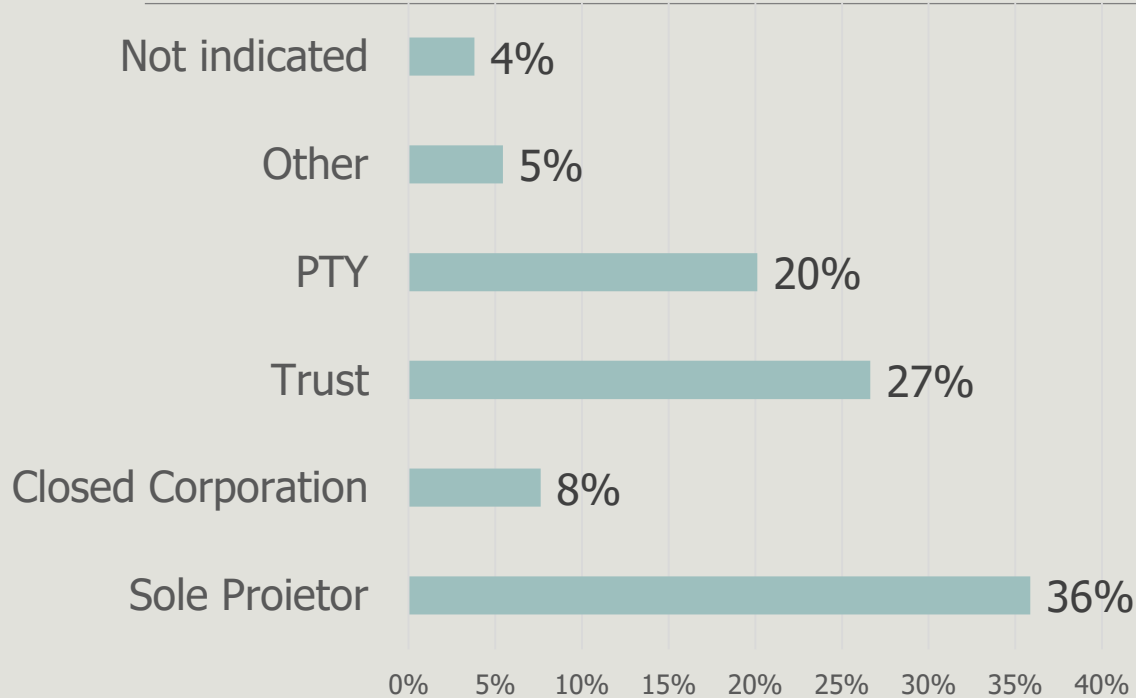
- 185 interviews

PERCENTAGE OF FARMS WITHIN A SPECIFIC BIOME



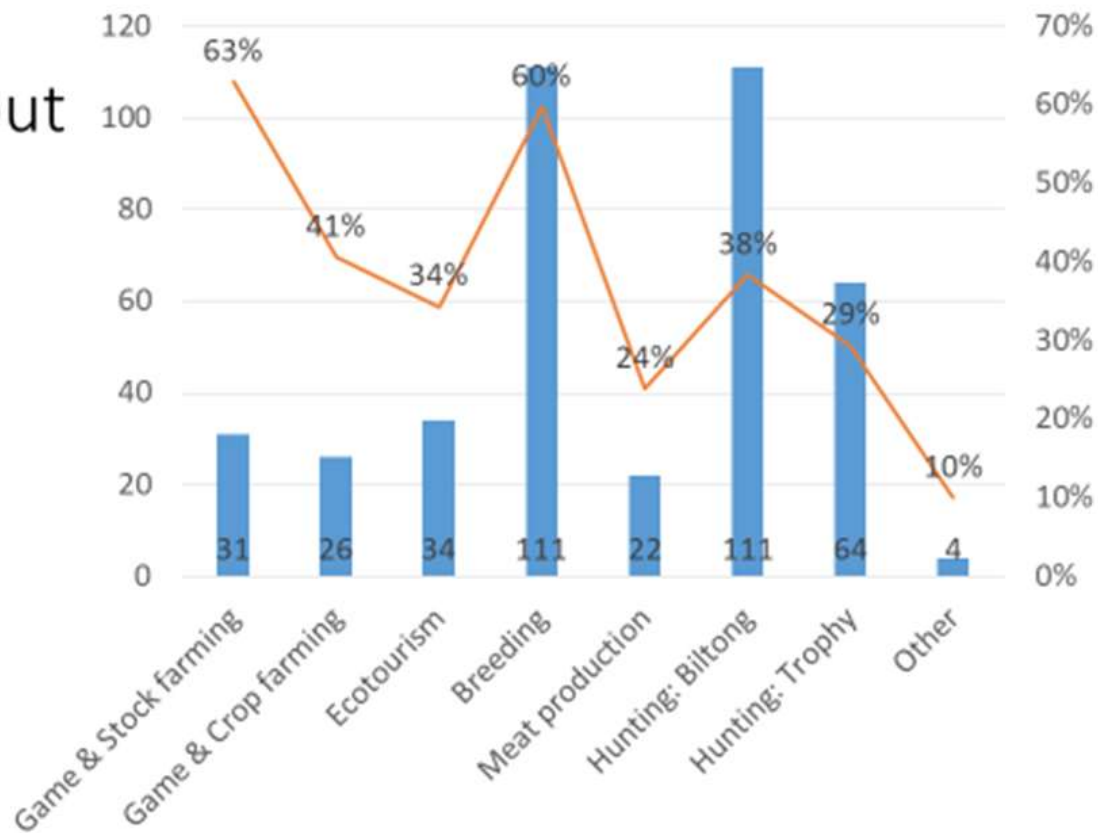
TYPE OF OWNERSHIP



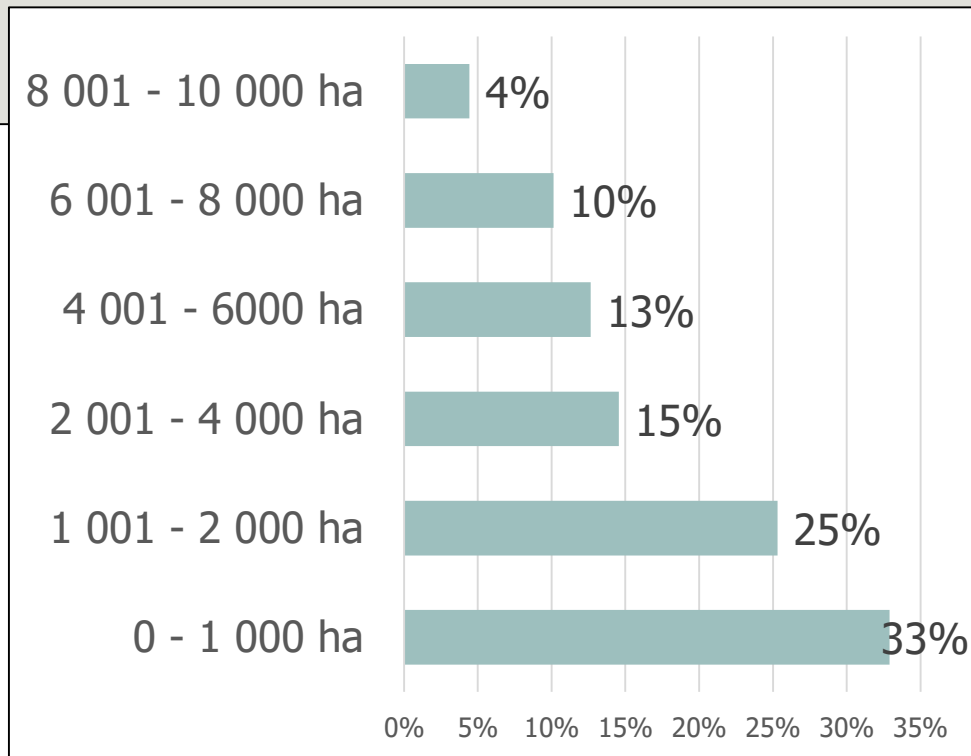
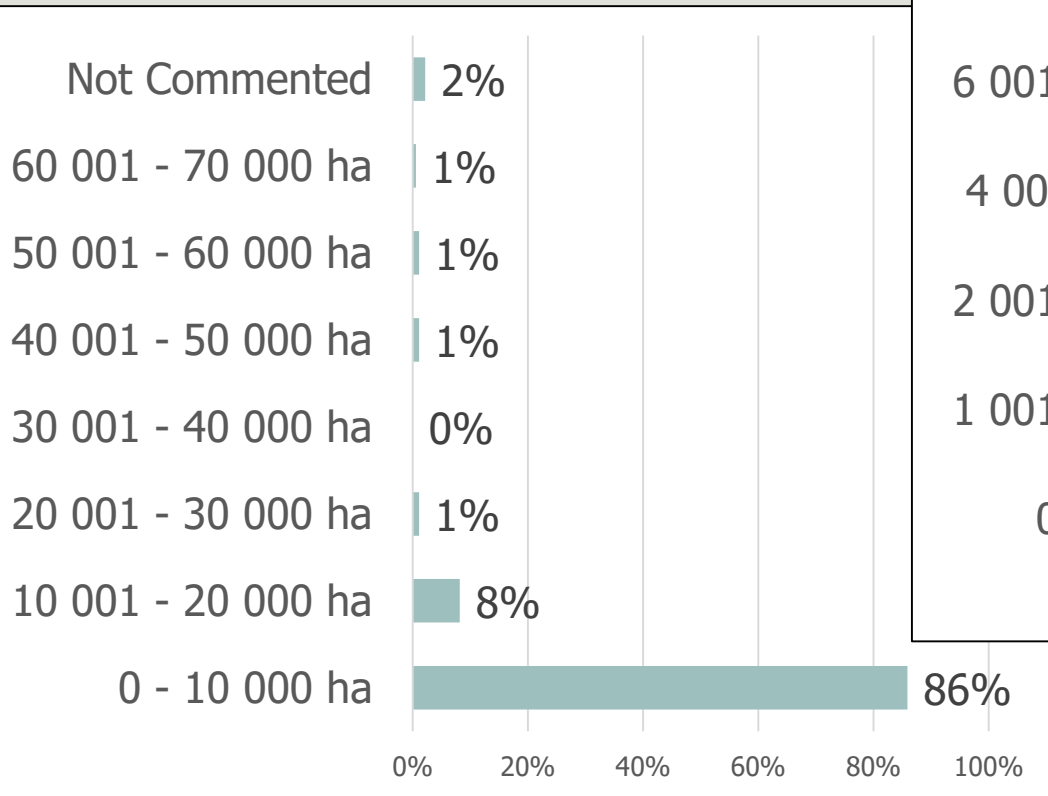
Production Output

— Average percentage production output

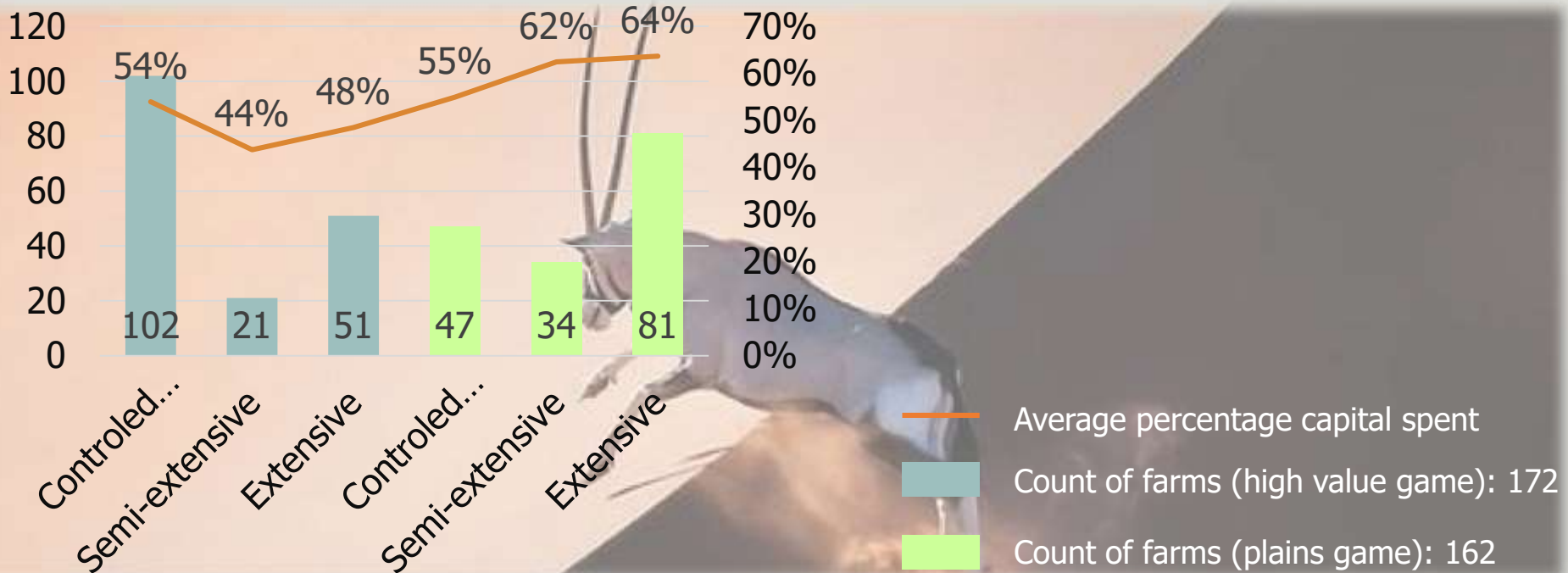
■ Count of farms



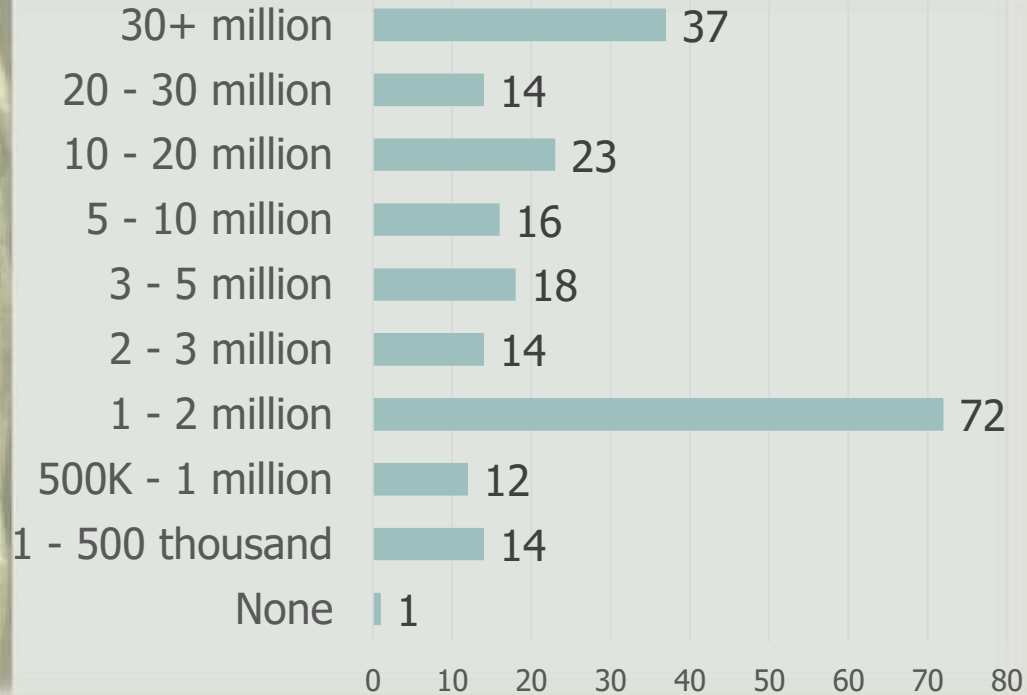

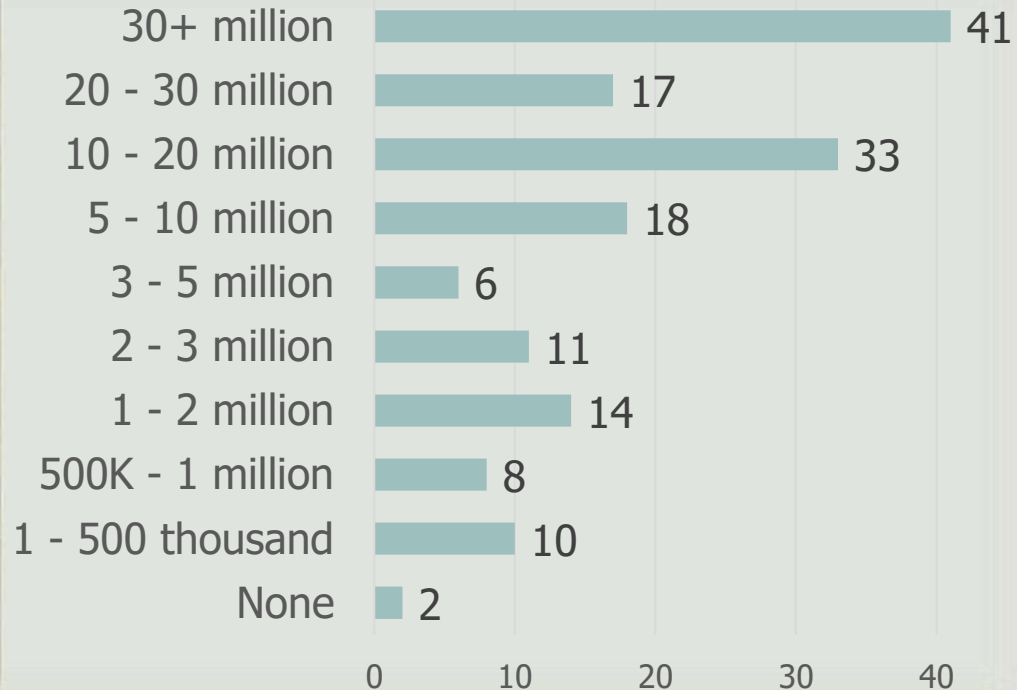
INTENSIVE VS EXTENSIVE FARMING PRACTICES



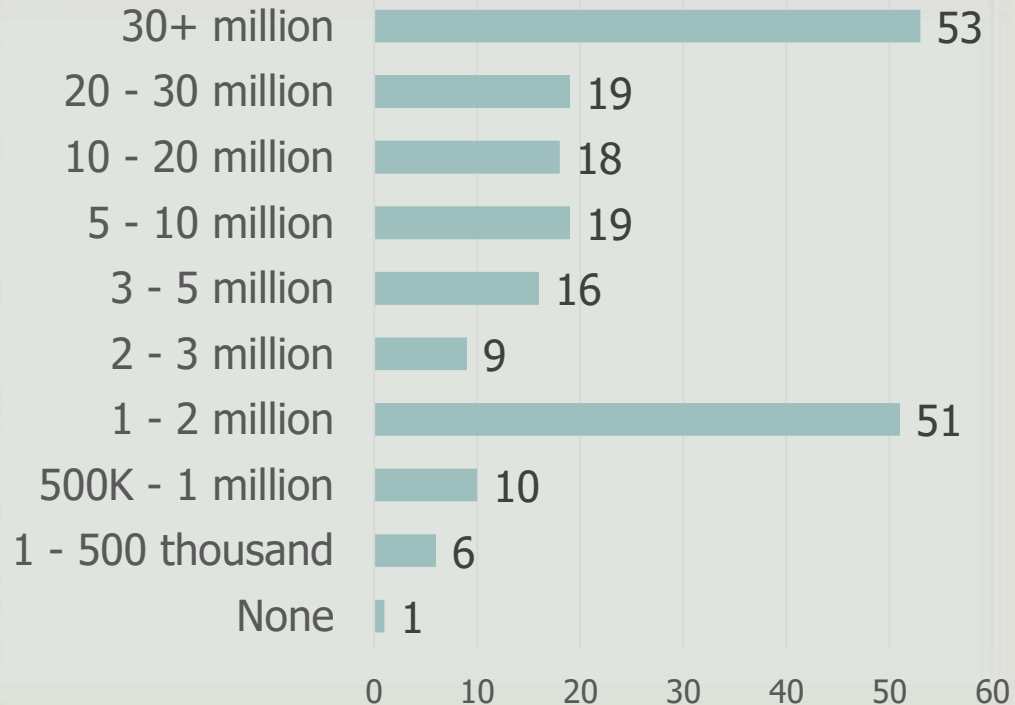
CAPITAL EXPENDITURE: INFRASTRUCTURE



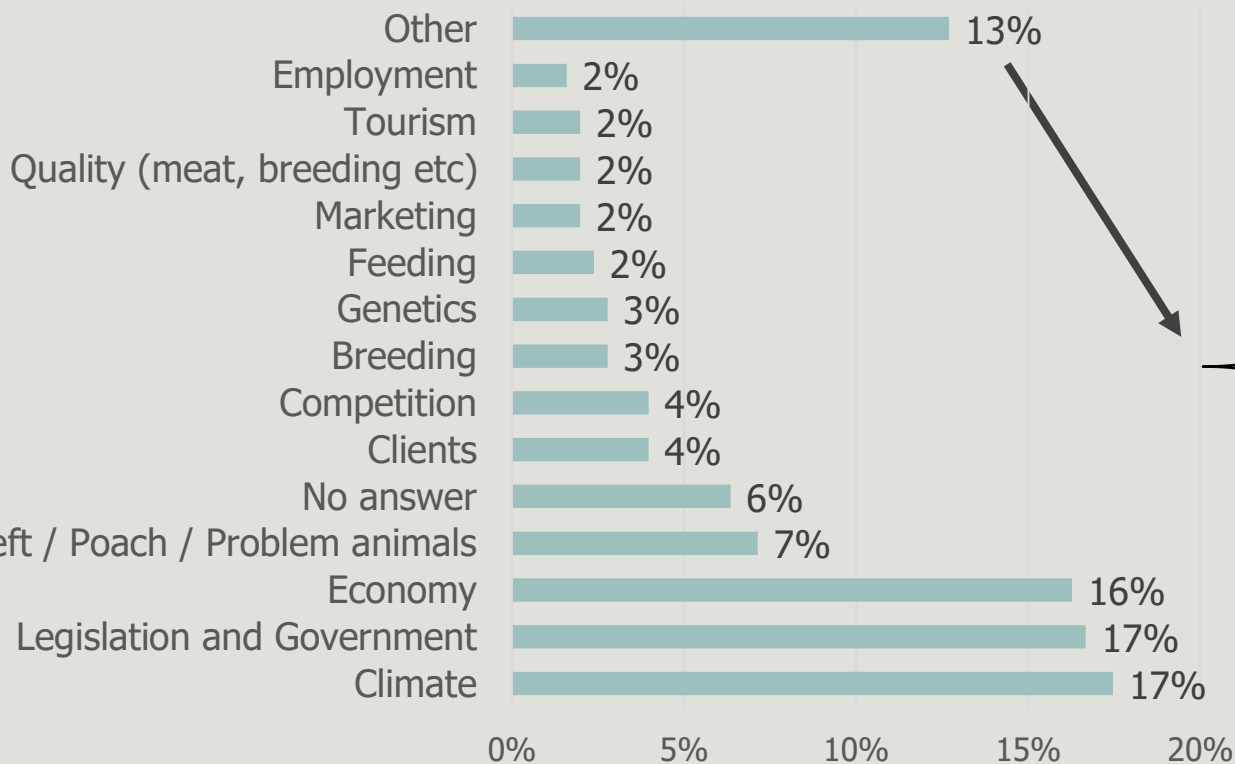
CAPITAL EXPENDITURE: LAND



CAPITAL EXPENDITURE: ANIMALS

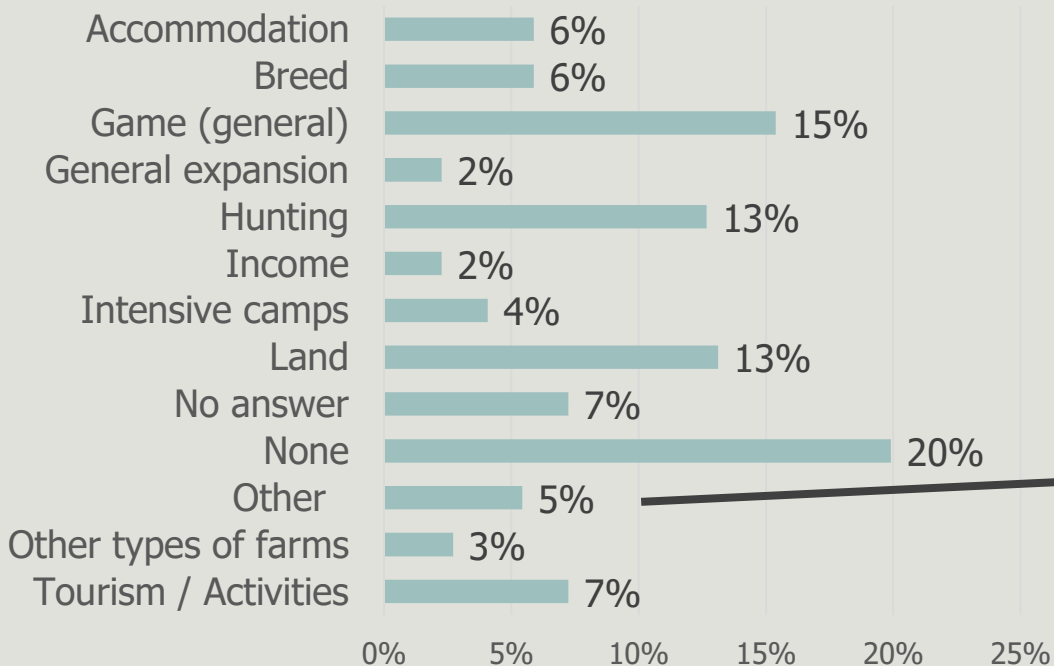


BIGGEST CHALLENGES IN INDUSTRY
